Dear Parent/Guardian,

Did you know that when kids don't read over the summer they are likely to fall behind when they head back to school? These learning losses are often called the "Summer Slide," and it is a priority and passion of mine to keep our students' skills sharp by encouraging them to read all summer long.

RPE is excited to announce a summer reading incentive! Students who read or are read to 15 minutes a day 70% of the days over summer vacation will be treated to a pizza party in the fall. Please consider reading with your child. Books that are enjoyed via other reading programs can count! Our county library has a reading program I encourage you to sign up for as well as 4-H Youth Programming.

Another opportunity to get books into your kids' hands is summer checkout from the RPE library.

The Rock Port R-II library will run its summer checkout program from Tuesday, May 15 to Friday, May 18, 2018. Before checking out, students need to return the attached permission form. Students who have lost/overdue books that have not been returned or paid for may check out 5 books at a time; students in good standing may check out up to (15) books for the summer. Books will be due back to the library by Friday of the first full week of school (August 24, 2018).

Students may make book exchanges for new titles during the summer. The elementary library will be open before and after summer school sessions and Tuesday evenings from 5-7 through June 26. If I am able to open the library again later in the summer, after the custodial staff has finished their work, I will make an announcement via the school homepage, Blue Jay Alert, Twitter, and email.

Students not returning, for whatever reason, to Rock Port in the fall should not participate.
