TRANSPORTATION
Buses will run on regular scheduled times on the morning of August 16. Students will need to sign up, during registration, for bus routes in the elementary or secondary principal's office.

DIRECTORY INFORMATION
The district, in conformance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), declares the following as "Directory Information." As provided in that act, this information concerning students may be made public:

1. Student's name, address, telephone listing
2. Date and place of birth.
3. Pictures.
4. Participation in officially recognized activities
5. Weight and height of members of athletic teams.
6. Dates of attendance
7. Honors and awards achieved.

This public notice is required by law before such information can be placed in yearbooks, student directories, or other student publications. If any parent or legal guardian does not want any of this information released without his or her consent, he or she may contact the principal of the school the student attends within thirty days of this notice.

STUDENT EARLY DISMISSAL PROCEDURES
The following procedures apply:

1. The building principal or designee shall not excuse a student before the end of the school day without a request for early dismissal by the student's parent/guardian.
2. Requests shall be in writing. Telephone requests for early dismissal of a student shall be honored only if the caller can be positively identified as the student's parent/guardian.
3. Children of single-parent families will be released only upon the request of the custodial parent; i.e., the parent whom the court holds directly responsible for the child, and who is identified as such on the school record.
4. Any student who leaves school during the school day must be signed out by a parent/guardian in the elementary or high school office. Elementary students entering school while school is in session must be signed in by parent/guardian.
5. Students should never leave the school grounds without permission from the principal's office.

SCHOOL CLOSING PROCEDURES
The decision to close school because of inclement weather is normally reached between 5:30 to 6 a.m. after a survey of pertinent conditions has been made. If the administration, or employees designated by them, judge school should be closed that day, notices will be given as soon as possible to radio stations KFEL (680 AM), KMA (960 AM), KSJQ (92.7 FM), and KKBZ (99.1 FM); KQTV television station in St. Joseph; and Channel 60. Notices will also be sent via text message on Blue Jay Alerts.
If school is dismissed early in the afternoon because of inclement weather, notice will be given to the above stations as soon as the decision has been made to close school. Administrators will make every effort possible to contact the parents of grade school children that school is dismissing early so that proper supervision of the children will be secured when they reach home.

Please do not send your children to school before 8 a.m. in the morning unless they are engaged in some activity which requires them to be there early. Children eating breakfast at school may come after 7:30 a.m.
